

Guidelines to E-Poster

SODC is glad to bring an e-poster competition for its budding and aspiring dermatologists guests. Ensure your presence with your poster so that the interested delegates can come and discuss your poster with you in person. Thus giving you the required opportunities to get that dream exposure and academic suggestions.

E-poster submissions should adhere to the following guidelines and the final outcome of the same should be in the form of an uploaded PDF File.

Guidelines for preparation of Posters:

- LAYOUT-To standardize the layout SODC prescribes the following guidelines for framing the layout of the posters.
 - i) Dimensions-All the posters should be portrait, measuring a maximum of 1m width *1.5 m high. The letters of the title should be at least not lesser than 2.5 cm high,
 - **ii)** Text Requirements-The text body lettering should be 2 meters away for comfortable reading by the audience and should not be less than be of 1 cm height. Font used should be of a clear and legible format like Times New Roman etc. Refrain from using all capital letters.
 - **iii)** Headings-Maintaining a constant rhythm for the headings like all capital, boldfaced, italicized etc would be appreciated.
 - iv) Ordering of Illustrations-To get a smooth flow of ideas for yourself and the audience, number or letter each illustration, maintain the uniformity throughout so that you can easily relate the same and incorporate it into your text. Try to give each chart /table/diagram a heading or label or explanation.
- 2. **JUDGMENT CRITERIA** Applicability of the poster subject with relation to the conference, authenticity of the information, quality and utility from teaching point of view, visual-aid employed and their effect on the poster as a whole.
- ARRANGEMENT ORDER OF THE POSTERS For purpose of uniformity and ease of understanding ,SODC has emphasized on a homogenous array of arrangement of the posters-
 - I) **Introduction** A short opening brief that would help the audience to understand the purpose of the study and connect to it.
 - ii) **Methods employed**-the different methods employed to conduct the study that would give a broad picture of the study.
 - iii) **References** Any kind of references in the form of heading etc should be properly acknowledged with the author's, writer's etc name and the belongingness of the same from the respective institution should be earmarked with.
 - iv) **Results**: Any kind of diagram, illustrations, graphs, figures and photos illustrating the results of various examinations/surveys etc.
 - v) **Conclusion** A short paragraph or a featured summary.

SODC will have the e-poster display within the poster area. The display of these posters will solely be accessible to those attending the conference.
